

**Cambridge City Council – Canvassing Board Special Meeting Minutes
Friday, November 9, 2018**

A special meeting of the Cambridge City Council was held on Friday, November 9, 2018, at Cambridge City Hall Council Chambers, 300 3rd Avenue NE, Cambridge, Minnesota, 55008.

Members Present: Mayor Marlys Palmer; Council Members Jim Godfrey, Lisa Iverson, Joe Morin and Kersten Conley.

Members Absent: None.

Staff Present: City Administrator Woulfe, Director of Finance Moe, and Public Works-Utilities Director Schwab.

Call to Order and Approval of Agenda.

Palmer called the meeting to order at 3:30 pm.

Review of Election Abstract

Woulfe noted the total number of persons voting in the 2018 municipal election were 3, 554. The number of voters that registered on election day were 367. Voter turnout for Precinct 1 was 64.39% and 62.31% for Precinct 2.

Woulfe noted the referendum on the local option sales tax passed by a vote of 2,115 Yes to 1,317 No.

Woulfe indicated the election judges worked hard to maintain the integrity of the election and appreciated the service of the election judges. Woulfe reported the Poll Books worked very well and cut down on waiting time for voters.

Certification of Winners

Iverson moved, seconded by Morin, to certify the following winners for the 2018 City municipal election:

City Question 1, Local Option Sales Tax Passed with 2,115 yes votes.
