A special meeting of the Cambridge City Council was held on Friday, November 13, 2020 to serve as the Canvassing Board for the 2020 General Election at Cambridge City Hall Council Chambers, 300 3rd Avenue NE, Cambridge, Minnesota, 55008.

Members Present: Council Members Lisa Iverson, Joe Morin, Kersten Conley, and Bob Shogren.

Members Absent: Jim Godfrey.

Staff Present: City Administrator Woulfe and Assistant City Administrator Evan Vogel.

Call to Order

Acting May Iverson called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

Review of Election Abstract

Woulfe reported that a total of 2,799 voters voted in Precinct 1 and 2,271 voters voted in Precinct 2 for a total of 5,070 votes.


Adjournment
