

Subcontractor List

A building permit applicant shall be deemed the contractor and shall possess a state contractor license as required by State Statute. However, if the applicant owns a single-family home upon which the work is being done, the applicant may obtain a permit for construction. Any participant other than the homeowner/applicant shall be listed on the permit application, and the participant shall possess a valid license. The permit shall not be issued until all contractors listed on the permit application have a valid license as required by State Statute.
