



ADDITIONAL EVENTS & OPPORTUNITIES

The **Community Garden** opens for the season on May 1st. There is often a waiting list, so register early if you would like a plot. The Annual Isanti County Master Gardener Plant and Yard Sale will be on June 1st from 9-12pm.

The Cambridge **Dog Park** is located at 1801 East Rum River Dr S, next to the Community Garden. A public **shuffleboard** court is available at Parkwood Park located at 1920 18th Ln SE. City Hall has cues and discs available for check out.

Disc Golf is available at the Cambridge City Park located at 810 2nd Ave SW. It is a 9-hole course in which you try to complete each hole with the fewest number of throws possible. Map available online and discs available for check out at City Hall.



The **Skate Park** is at Central Green Park located at 1455 Fern St S.

Bankshot is a basketball court that takes players through a course of nine (9) different backboards and angles. It's universally designed for all ages and abilities. The sport is intended to be self-competitive. Participants play alongside, not against each other. Available at Brown Park located at 905 24th Ave SW.


