	Consumer fireworks sales and display shall be limited to mercantile occupancies as defined in NFPA 10, <i>Life Safety Code</i> ®.			
	No person shall construct a retail display nor offer for sale explosives, explosive materials, or fireworks upon			
	highways, sidewalks, public property, or in assembly or educational occupancies.			
	No manufacturing, sales, or storage for commercial purposes will occur on residentially zoned property or within 100			
_	feet thereof.			
	A list of all consumer fireworks displayed for sale and stored on the property will be available at all times. The list			
ш	will document the name, weight, and quantity of the fireworks and be accompanied by the material safety data sheets.			
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	The requirements of this ordinance are in addition to any requirements imposed by any building and zoning			
_	regulations, fire codes, or State law.			
	Open flames are not permitted inside or within 20 feet of the tent.			
	All fireworks fuses shall be contained within its package arrangement.			
	All electrical wiring shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code.			
	Temporary structures used for consumer fireworks retail sales are regulated by the National Fire Protection Agency			
	Standard 1124, Chapter 7, the Minnesota State Fire Code and City of Cambridge Ordinance. An additional building			
	permit may be required, and a separate application will be provided.			
	A site plan (of the whole property) shall be included which shows an aerial of the property, indicating where the			
	merchant would setup, and the below regulations:			
	o No person will sell or store consumer fireworks within 50 feet of any fuel dispensing apparatus unless the total			
	aggregate quantities of consumer fireworks are below the exempt amounts listed within Chapter 7 of NFPA 1124			
	Code for the Manufacture, Transportation, Storage, and Retail Sales of Fireworks and Pyrotechnic Articles®,			
	2003 Edition, within an approved structure or building.			
	o Shall be located within 150 feet of a public way for fire department access.			
	o Approved minimum separation distances in compliance with table 7.7.2 of NFPA 1124® shall be provided from			
	the exterior display to adjacent buildings, combustibles, or flammable liquids.			
	<ul> <li>Shall have a 20-foot building and combustible storage setback.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Shall be provided with a 10-foot vehicle parking setback.</li> </ul>			
	A Floor Plan (of the firework sales area) shall be included which shows an aerial of the sales site, and the below

	It will be unlawful for any seller of any fireworks to permit smoking at any site containing fireworks. Provide no			
	smoking signs at each entrance with at least 2-inch-high letters on contrasting background outside the tent that			
	say, "No Smoking within 50 feet."			
	Only persons 18 years of age or older may purchase fireworks, and the age of the purchaser must be verified by photographic identification. Provide a sign that states "must be 18 years old to purchase fireworks."			
	o Provide at least 2 portable fire extinguishers with a minimum rating of 2A and at least one must be of the			
	pressurized water type.			
	Egress travel distance shall not exceed 75 feet from most remote point to exit.			
	<ul> <li>At least two exits are required and shall be marked by approved EXIT signs.</li> </ul>			
	o Aisles shall have a minimum 48 inches of clear width and have no dead ends.			
	<ul> <li>Not more than 50 percent of the floor area shall be used for retail sales.</li> </ul>			
	o Display case heights are limited to 12 feet around perimeter and 6 feet for interior.			
	o Provide a vertical flame break 6 inches above displays for every 16 feet of display cases.			
	After a permit is issued, the permit applicant shall schedule an inspection of the above requirements before beginning			
	sales of fireworks. Call 763-552-3210 to schedule all inspections.
