Cambridge City Council Meeting Minutes Monday, June 19, 2017

A regular meeting of the Cambridge City Council was held on Monday, June 19, 2017, at Cambridge City Hall Council Chambers, 300 3rd Avenue NE, Cambridge, Minnesota, 55008.

Members Present: Mayor Marlys Palmer; Council Members Kersten Conley, Joe Morin, Lisa

Iverson, and Jim Godfrey. All present, no absences.

Staff Present: City Administrator Lynda Woulfe, Finance Director Caroline Moe,

Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

Palmer called the meeting to order at 6:21 pm and led the public in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Citizens Forum

No citizens addressed the City Council.

Approval of the Agenda

Iverson added "Facebook" under Council Concerns. Iverson moved, seconded by Morin, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda

Iverson moved, seconded by Conley, to approve consent agenda Items A-G:

- A. Regular and Summary City Council Meeting Minutes for June 5, 2017
- B. Warrants #105965 #106218 and ACH/Wire items totaling \$1,270,913.53
- C. Approve Ordinance 644 Amendment to Allow Food Trucks in All Zoning Districts for Special Events (churches, schools, City Parks)
- D. Approve Hire of Eric Haakanson, Step 1 (\$20.78 per hour), Water-Wastewater Operator
- E. Resolution R17-033 Amending 2017 General Fund Budget
- F. Purchase Agreement for 100 Main Street South for Highway 95 Right of Way
- G. Contract with Patchin, Messner, and Dodd for Appraisal Services for Highway 95 Right of Way

Upon call of the roll Morin, Palmer, Conley, Iverson, and Godfrey voted aye, no nays. Motion carried unanimously.

There was no business under Work Session

Unfinished Business

Interim Use Permit Request for Automobile Sales at 140 1st Ave W

Westover explained the request for an Interim Use Permit for automobile sales and minor automotive service was tabled at the May 15, 2017 Council meeting to allow review of parking on site. Westover presented the site design submitted by LHB, Inc which identifies 14

true parking spaces. The 14 "angled" spaces are the true spaces allowed by code. Westover explained the remaining spaces shown on the plan (spaces 7-14 and 23-25) are not allowed as parking spaces for customers or employees coming and going on a daily basis because they don't provide proper ingress and/or egress to the site.

Westover reported the representative that she has been working with, Paul Walker, has expressed an interest in only parking the vehicle's for sale (the "display" vehicles) in these spaces (spaces 7-14 and 23-25). Westover stated the vehicles would not be coming and going on a daily basis and would be more or less permanent display spaces.

Westover reported Mr. Walker has agreed to only using the property for automobile sales and there will be no automobile repair as originally requested. With this change of scope for the interim use permit, Automobile Sales only requires 13 on-site parking spaces. Westover stated Mr. Walker mentioned the business could also have display vehicles inside the building.

Westover stated if Council approves the Interim Use Permit request, it is recommended that a condition of approval is added to the Resolution that the owner must find an acceptable alternative location for the use upon termination of the Interim Use Permit.

Godfrey confirmed they could not use the parking spaces for display. Palmer confirmed the Planning Commission recommended denial because the main focus on downtown is improving the look and feel and wanting revitalization. Morin felt it would better to have someone temporarily utilizing the building versus it being vacant.

Woulfe asked if the purchase had been recorded. Attorney Patrick Neaton stated it has not been recorded and explained they are waiting on a tax ID which will be completed within a week. Squires recommended adding as a condition to the permit the property ownership issue must be resolved and recorded.

Patrick Neaton, attorney for TTJ Properties, LLC raised several concerns including a sentence that was omitted from Chapter 8 of the Comprehensive Plan which states: "A wide variety of land uses are allowed under the Downtown Business District zoning, including retail, commercial, mixed use, and "dwelling units, not on the ground level floor"." Neaton stated he could not find anything in the Comprehensive Plan or Zoning Code that prohibits auto sales in the Downtown area. Neaton argued from his perspective auto sales is a legal use in the area. Neaton stated there are several businesses that do not have onsite parking in the downtown area including the post office. Neaton stated his opinion that one year is not feasible for the tenant because of the money he intends to put towards improving the building façade. Neaton expressed concern if the permit is not granted, the building would remain vacant and become more deteriorated and that if retail or offices were to occupy the building there is interior remodeling that would need to occur which is cost prohibitive if the Highway 95 project goes through in the next few years.

Kevin Wudel of 416 11th Ave SW, Cambridge, Minnesota stated there are several parking issues all over downtown and the people make it work by parking in one of the public parking lots. Wudel stated he does not have parking issues at the building and meets the minimum requirements. Wudel requested Council grant the permit for longer than one year.

Iverson questioned why Wudel opted to have the auto sales on the 140 1st Avenue property instead of the Main Street North property. Wudel stated he was not sure of the status of the property on Main St. N. Neaton explained that lot is currently in foreclosure.

Iverson moved, seconded by Morin to approve Resolution R17-036 Approving an Interim Use permit to allow Automobile Sales in the B-1 Zoning District (Site Address 140 – 1st Ave W) with the following conditions:

- 1. The Interim Use for automobile sales is not transferrable and shall only be used by Kevin and Briana Wudel and shall discontinue on June 19, 2019.
- 2. Section 156.090 Auto-Oriented Uses of the City Code must be met at all times, where applicable.
- 3. If parking demand exceeds the parking provided, the interim use shall cease.
- 4. Kevin and Briana Wudel must find an alternative location for their business prior to termination of the Interim Use permit.

Squires recommended amending the motion to include a fifth condition:

5. The approval shall be void if the applicant fails to provide proof of recording (with the Isanti County Recorder's Office and Isanti County Auditors Office) of the ownership change within 30 days of the date of approval of the Interim Use Permit.

Morin and Iverson agreed to amend their motion to include the language recommended by the City Attorney.

Godfrey recommended amending the motion to have the permit expire on December 31, 2018 because of the Highway 95 reconstruction project. Staff explained they were not sure the project would be started that early. There was no second for the amendment to the motion.

Upon call of the roll, motion carried 4/1 with Morin, Palmer, Iverson, and Godfrey voting yay and Conley voting nay.

Sister City Commission Applications

Moe stated on March 20, 2017, the Cambridge City Council adopted ordinance 639 establishing the structure for a Sister Cities Commission and appointing its membership of seven to nine members, one of which is required to be a member of the City Council. Moe explained according to the ordinance members were required to be City residents or owners of a City business.

Moe stated the City published a press release soliciting and advertised on the City's Facebook page for membership applications on April 4 with a deadline of May 9th and with that initial solicitation, the City received two applications from people meeting the ordinance

criteria for membership. Moe stated the City also received one application from a person that no longer lives within the City but who has previously worked on Cambridge's Sister City committee.

Moe reported on May 26, the City issued an updated press release soliciting and advertised on the City's Facebook page for membership application with an updated deadline of June 13th and the City received two additional applicants. Moe reviewed the options identified in the staff report.

Godfrey confirmed the reasoning commission versus committee was because of fund raising. Godfrey recommended revising ordinance to allow an extra-territorial member.

Palmer confirmed they don't have to wait for the ordinance amendment to appoint commission members but would have to wait to appoint an extra-territorial member. Iverson recommended limiting the commission to one extra territorial member.

Godfrey moved, seconded by Morin, to appoint: Vicki Ostrom, Jackie Pemble, Mark Ziebarth, Boris Miksic (or a representative from Cortec), and Mike Stylski and directed staff to modify the Sister City Commission ordinance language to permit one extra territorial member. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business

Storm Water Public Hearing

Alysa Zimmerle and Emily Erdahl presented Council with information on the City's 2017 Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan. Schwab commended Zimmerle's work with stormwater compliance and updating the program to keep up with Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's (MPCA) mandates.

Palmer opened the public hearing at 7:29 pm and with no comments, closed the public hearing at 7:30 pm.

Approve Resolution R17-034 Preliminary Plat of Cortec Addition with Minor Amendment Approve Resolution R17-035 Final Plat of Cortec Addition with Minor Amendment

Westover stated the Cortec Addition preliminary and final plats had been reviewed by the Planning Commission on April 4, 2017, and reviewed and approved by Council on April 17, 2017. Westover explained since then, additional discoveries have been found and minor changes needed to be made to the plat.

Westover reported upon additional title work discovery, it was found that Miksic Realty (Cortec) owns an additional 50' piece originally thought to be owned by the adjacent laundromat property and this has now been added to the amended plat. Westover stated in addition, Cortec discovered the adjacent residential property has a driveway on the Cortec property so in order to correct this, Cortec is giving this residential property the driveway land and moving the property line further to the north.

Westover reported at their meeting on June 6, 2017, the Commission recommended approval of the Preliminary and Final Plats as amended on a 5/0 vote.

Morin moved, seconded by Iverson to approve resolutions R17-034 Resolution Approving an Amendment to the Preliminary Plat for Cortec Addition at 410 1st Ave E and R17-035 Approving an Amendment to the Final Plat for Cortec Addition at 410 1st Ave E as presented provided the following conditions are met:

- 1. The applicant has filed a Site Plan Review application with the City for site work and an addition to be done. The Site Plan Review must be completed to the satisfaction of the City prior to the building permit being issued.
- 2. A copy of the recorded final plat must be submitted to the City within 5 days of recording. The final plat must be recorded prior to a Certificate of Occupancy being issued.
- 3. The plat shall include all drainage and utility easements required by the City as part of the Site Plan approval.
- 4. The applicant shall obtain necessary easements to connect applicant's stormwater pond to the City pond to the north of applicant's property if they determine they are going to connect to the pond north of Cortec. Motion carried unanimously.

Request to Cover Up No Parking Signs for Auction at 1115 Adams Street South

Dwyer stated Resident Gerald E. Anderson of 1115 Adams St S, Cambridge MN is requesting permission from the Cambridge City Council to cover up the no parking signs on 11th Ave SW from Old Main St East to Carriage Hills Drive S. Dwyer stated this is to accommodate parking for an auction which he desires to hold on his property in the near future. Dwyer explained the exact date is dependent on City Council approval or disapproval of the parking plan.

Dwyer explained Anderson's request is for one day only (either a Saturday or Sunday) and he explained to staff this is a one-time event and will be less than 8 hours in length. Dwyer stated Anderson agreed that he could cover up the signs and take the covers off at the end of the auction, so there would be no city staff time required.

Dwyer noted at this time, there was no request for Officer or Reserve presence, but if there is, the city fee schedule would apply because this is a private event. Council reviewed the different parking options along with advantages and disadvantages to parking on 11th Avenue SE.

Morin moved, seconded by Iverson, to approve the south side of 11th Ave SE parking signs to be covered up and to permit parking for the auction. Godfrey questioned the child activity being there is apartments and townhomes adjacent to that area and asked the motion to be amended to restrict parking in front of that area. Morin and Iverson amended the motion to cover up the no parking signs on the north side of 11th Ave SE for the date of the auction with a timeline to be agreed upon with staff. Motion carried unanimously.

Customer Appreciation Street Closure Request

Monte Dybvig, chair of the Customer Appreciation Event, and Woulfe presented Council with the staff report. The 2017 Downtown Customer Appreciation Event will take place on Friday, September 15th from 4:00-8:00 pm. The Event's planning group is requesting the closure of:

Main Street North from Highway 95 to Second Ave. NE
Main Street South from Highway 95 to Third Avenue SE
Adams Street from Highway 95 to Third Avenue SE
Second Avenue from Birch to Buchanan St. S
Ashland Street from mid-block South of Main St to Third Ave SE
Entrances and exits to the alleys within this area

from 1:00 pm until 10:00 pm (or until clean-up is complete which depends upon the number of people they have to take down tables/chairs).

Woulfe noted there has not been any adverse issues with this event and that the event is covered under the City's general liability insurance.

Morin moved, seconded by Conley, to approve the street closure request as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Isanti County purchase of 210 Emerson Street North from the City of Cambridge

Woulfe explained the purchase agreement is a standard agreement that had been previously drafted by City Attorney Squires' office. Woulfe confirmed the sale price is \$300,000 and the County would like to close on or before July 1, 2017. Woulfe stated Isanti County has indicated the City will be able to use the second garage through the end of November rent free with the caveat they technically won't "kick the City out".

Godfrey moved, seconded by Palmer, to approve the sale of 210 Emerson Street North to Isanti County for \$300,000 as outlined in the agreement. Morin stated he did not feel comfortable with not having the language in the purchase agreement that the City can use the garage until April 2018. Upon call of the roll, motion passed with Palmer, Conley, and Godfrey voting aye; Morin and Iverson voting nay (3 ayes/2 nays).

Sister City – 30th Anniversary Information

Morin distributed a brochure that was created by Yuasa Japan celebrating the 30th anniversary of their Sister City relationship.

Approve Replacement of Plumbing Re-circulation Line in Police Department, City hall & Fire Department

Gustafson stated the object and purpose of this project is to replace a re-circulating hot water line that runs across numerous offices to avoid the possibility of a leak. Gustafson explained this has happened before in the Police Department which created additional damage and

cost. Gustafson stated staff has contacted other contractors to provide bids, appointments were made and they did not show up. Gustafson explained contractors are busy and have limited time to provide bids along with getting the project done in a timely manner.

Gustafson reviewed the one bid staff received from TM Johnson Brothers, Inc. Gustafson noted staff is bringing this proposal to Council because it is not a scheduled budgeted maintenance item and staff needs to make sure this item is taken care before there is a leak that will cause additional damage and cost. Gustafson stated staff has been in contact with Administration and Finance on this project and the Finance Department will bring to the Council at a future date a budget adjustment. Gustafson concluded the pipe has no time limit as to if it will break, it is a matter of when it will break.

Morin moved, seconded by Iverson, to approve the quote submitted by TM Johnson Bros. Inc, for an amount not to exceed \$5,100.00 and authorized the Mayor and City Administrator to sign the proposal with TM Johnson Bros. Inc. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve Request for Proposal (RFP) and Building Removal Addendum to Offer to Sell for Homes Purchased for Highway 95 Right-of-Way

Gustafson stated the City has purchased two homes on Highway 95 for future Right of Way and the RFP will be used to solicit potential home movers to move the homes off site to a new location or to salvage the homes and make all necessary corrections to the site. Gustafson noted all RFP's will be brought back to City Council for approval or denial at a later date. Morin confirmed if they sell the homes, the funds will go back into the same account.

Godfrey moved, seconded by Iverson, to approve the Request for Proposal (RFP) for House Removal and Addendum to Offer to Sell and Memorandum of Conditions Agreement to remove Buildings and authorize staff to post the RFP. Motion carried unanimously.

Adopt a Basket Program

Woulfe explained they are working with Discover Downtown Committee to replace the cement flower planters on the corners and put out hanging baskets on the light poles to create a consistent decoration theme. Woulfe described the baskets and reported she checked with the Garden Club to ensure they supported the idea. Woulfe reported the Garden Club left her a voicemail message that they wholeheartedly support the hanging baskets and felt it would beautify the downtown area.

lverson confirmed citizens can also adopt a basket. Palmer asked what staff plans to do with the existing planters. Woulfe stated they would like to repurpose them and put them in the parks or along 2nd & 3rd Avenues NE/SE until that area can be filled with hanging baskets. Palmer suggested repurposing them in the immediate downtown area.

Iverson moved, seconded by Conley, to support the Adopt a Basket program and the understanding that Public Works would need to water the baskets. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor's Report

Palmer provided an update on meetings attended and upcoming meetings and events.

Council Concerns

Facebook

Iverson stated one of the break-out sessions she attended at the League of Minnesota Cities conference was related to social media. Iverson explained they were told the City's should combat false narratives and incorrect information. Woulfe explained it has been the direction of the current Council to not respond to posts outside of the City of Cambridge's own Facebook page. Iverson expressed concern about recent posts on a page titled: "City of Cambridge Information Page" which had incorrect information.

Discussion ensued on the advantages and disadvantages with posting on other pages that contain false information. Council felt they owed it to the public to provide correct information, but felt additional postings to the City's "Official" Facebook page related to rumors might be the right direction. Council directed staff to make sure postings on the City's page are available to the public.

Palmer confirmed a letter has been sent to the Facebook administrator of the "City of Cambridge Information Page" directing the name be changed. Woulfe explained the name of the page is still in violation with the Ordinance and asked the Council to provide direction to Squires on if they would like to seek an injunctive order on the use of the City's name. Squires stated there two other options for the Council to consider. They could seek administrative enforcement or they can forward to the prosecutor for criminal charges.

Godfrey felt the City should concentrate on posting correct statements on the official page.

Discussion ensued by Council and it was the consensus to direct staff to present a communication plan to Council at a future meeting.

City Attorney's Report

Squires gave a briefing since the last meeting which included an update on 509 Main Street North. A question was posed whether or not animals can reside at a property. Squires advised staff to look into the zoning code to see if it precludes animals.

City Administrator's Report

Woulfe gave an update on the Ace Tack Building and an upcoming meeting with representatives from the Teen Center, Young Life, and the Cambridge Center for the Arts. Mayor Palmer indicated she would attend the meeting.

Adjournment

Being no further business before the City Council, Godfrey moved, seconded by Conley, to adjourn the regular meeting at 8:59 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
