Call to Order

Palmer called the meeting to order at 3:30 pm. The Cambridge City Council then held a special closed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, §13D.05, subd. 2(b) to give preliminary consideration to allegations against Tim Dwyer, an employee subject to the Council's authority.

lverson moved, seconded by Morin, to adjourn the closed session at 4:32 pm. The motion carried unanimously.

Morin moved, seconded by Conley to convene into open session at 4:34 pm. The motion carried unanimously.

Resignation Agreement

Conley moved, seconded by Godfrey, to accept the Resignation Agreement and Release of Claims for between Tim Dwyer and the City of Cambridge as presented. Upon call of the roll, all members voted aye. The motion carried unanimously.

Attorney Rupp stated the City received a number of allegations against Chief Dwyer. Following receipt of those allegations he was placed on administrative leave. Since that time the City and Chief Dwyer have reached an agreement for his resignation. That agreement is a public document. The City appreciates that this situation has come to a conclusion and will now begin its process for selecting a new chief.
